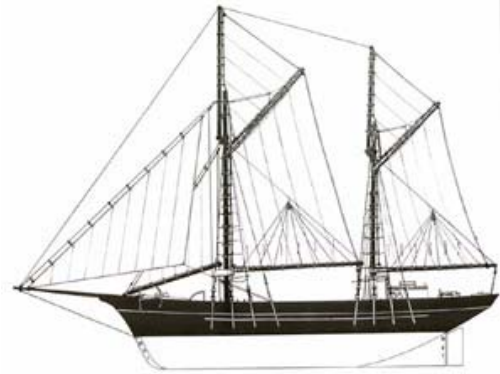


Working on a Ketch
