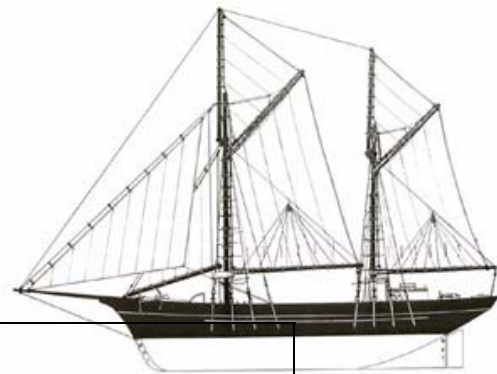


# Working on a Ketch
